UT Tyler Athletics Visitor Information

Entrance/Exit to Facility: Team bus can pull up to Herrington Stadium/Young Field. Drop off will be at the stadium main entrance. Teams should enter the facility at the Northwest Corner double gates, to the left of the main entrance. Team buses and Team vans are directed to park in the lots near the baseball stadium until filled.

INFIELD: Individuals with RED wristbands are to be in the infield – coaches and staff. ATHLETE WARMUPS are to take place on the infield ONLY in the designated flagged off areas.

Locker Room Availability: Locker Rooms are NOT available for both the Men's and Women's Teams.

Athletic Training Room Availability: The UT Tyler Athletic Training Staff will send instructions and details pertaining to the availability of Athletic Training Resources.

1. There will not be an institutional pass list. The pass list is for OFFICIALS/Workers only.
2. ADA Accommodations: Trained guide dogs, signal dogs, or "service animals" are permitted inside athletic venues.
3. Bag Search: All bags are subject to search upon entry and within athletic venues.
4. Banners and Signs: Are not allowed in the facility or surrounding venues.
5. Bottles and Cans: It is prohibited to enter athletic venues with glass bottles or cans. A search may be conducted at the gates to assist in maintaining an absence of these and other prohibited items from entering the stadium.
6. Cameras/Video Recorders: Hand-held still camera photography is permitted at games for noncommercial personal photography. The use of tripods or video photography of any type is not permitted.
7. Cellular Phones: Usage of cellular phones is allowed, so long as it does not disturb other fans in the area or interfere with their ability to enjoy the event.
8. Concession Stands: Brook Hill School will operate a concession. Outside food/Beverage is NOT allowed. These items should remain in your team camps outside the facility.
9. Coolers: Coolers are not allowed inside athletic venues.
10. Ejection: Law enforcement and game management personnel reserve the right to eject any person whose behavior is unruly or illegal in nature.
11. First Aid: First aid is available during all events by contact game management personnel.
12. Lost Children/Parents: All lost children should be escorted to the nearest game management staff member. Lost children will then be escorted to the nearest ticketing area. Lost parents should follow the same procedure.
13. Paging: Paging is permitted in case of medical emergencies only. If a medical emergency arises, contact the game management personnel.
14. Prohibited and Restricted Items
Alcohol; Bottles and Cans; Illegal Drugs; Confetti; Firearms and Weapons; Fireworks; Animals; Horns, whistles, noise makers; Signs, flags, and sticks; Umbrellas; Laser pointers; Food and beverages of any kind; Any container other than soft-sided purses, camera bags, fanny/back packs, and diaper bags less than 12" by 12" by 12"; Any item deemed to be a safety or security hazard.

15. Restrooms: Restrooms are located at all venues.
16. Stadium Emergencies: In the event of a serious emergency, game management staff, are available to assist all patrons, including those with disabilities.
17. Meet Personnel and Coaches are the only individuals allowed on the infield. NO spectators are allowed.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

Meet Classification: The Icebreaker Classic, March 19th, 2022, will be Collegiate/Post Collegiate unattached meet. Post Collegiate and Collegiate aged unattached athletes in individual events will be permitted.

NCAA regulations prohibit high school and/or middle school athletes from competing unattached in this meet.

HOW TO ENTER:

1. Entries will be processed through www.directathletics.com. Please access our meet at this website. **Entry fees are to be paid online through DirectAthletics.** You should set up your account in advance to avoid any problems. Unattached participants need to pay their registration fee online through DirectAthletics as well.
2. **Entry window opens March 1, 2022 and the deadline is Wednesday, March 15th, 2022 by 12:00pm.**
3. No faxed or phone entries will be accepted. They must be entered online.
4. Once entries have closed, changes will not be accepted. It is our goal to post the entries/heat sheets on the UT-TYLER website as soon as possible under meet information.

ENTRY FEES:

\$350 per team/per gender. Schools entering both men and women its \$700

Individual & Unattached entries will be \$20 per athlete.

All payments need to be completed via DirectAthletics.com

MEET INFORMATION:

Meet Site: Brook Hill School, 1051 North Houston Street, Bullard, TX 75757

Parking: Is available in the lots around the track and field complex. It is an 8-lane all-weather track, recently resurfaced in 2018 with NCAA legal pole vault and high jump landing systems.

Packet Pick-Up:

Heat Sheets can be picked up upon arrival to the meet at the admissions office window starting at 9:00 am. Please do not take more than 2 per team. Athletes will be given a BLUE wrist band, Coaches and Staff will be given RED wrist bands that will also give them infield access.

Meet Admissions:

The meet is open to the general public. Cost at the gate is \$5 per individual. Ages 8 and under are Free.

Dressing Facilities:

Unfortunately, there are no locker rooms or shower facilities available for this event. All other school facilities are to be off limits to all student athletes.

Athlete Check-in:

Field event athletes will be required to check-in 30 minutes prior to the start of their event at the event site. All running events should check in at the designated check-in area no less than 15 minutes prior to the event. The running events will go on a rolling schedule so be alert.

In the case of multiple scratches, heats will not be re-drawn. We will run them as they are unless there is just one individual.

Qualifying

The 100m dash and the 110/100m hurdles will run preliminary rounds. The top 8 times will advance to the final. All other races will be timed sectioned finals.

Implement Weigh-In:

Implements will be weighed in at the ticket booth area upon entering the stadium. All weigh-ins must be done between 8:00 am and 10:00 am.

Starting Heights:

Starting heights for the high jump and pole vaults will be determined by meet administration.

Warm-up:

Warm-ups are to take place outside of the track. The infield needs to remain clear except for a specified warm-up area.

Scoring:

This is a non-scoring meet. No team scores will be kept.
